## **DISCOUNT 10% FOR LATAR EXPRESSWAY USERS USING ELECTRONIC TOLL PAYMENTS ON DEEPAVALI DAY**

KUALA LUMPUR --- KL-Kuala Selangor Expressway Berhad, concessionaire for the new LATAR Expressway announced today that a discount of 10% will be given to LATAR users on 26<sup>th</sup> October 2011 in conjunction with Deepavali Festive Celebration.

In a statement issued today, KL-Kuala Selangor Expressway Berhad Chief Executive Officer Amran Amir, said "The discount will be given to all users who pay toll using Touch N' Go card and Smart Tags at all toll plazas on LATAR Expressway on 26<sup>th</sup> October 2011. This is part of the CSR initiative by LATAR Expressway to ease users travelling during the Deepavali celebration."

"In addition, users of LATAR Expressway may also top-up Touch N' Go cards at two of its toll plazas - Kuang Barat and Kuang Timur from 8.30 am - 10.00 pm Mondays to Fridays, with extended opening hours. Terms of payment for the tops-ups will be cash", said Amran.

LATAR Expressway wishes "Happy Deepavali" to all motorists and they are advised to ensure their vehicles are in safe conditions to travel back for "balik kampung" during the Deepavali Festive celebration. If any emergency or breakdown arises, LATAR Expressway provides free services to assist the motorists.

LATAR has its Emergency Response and Petroling Team (EXPERT) on patrolling 24-hours at the expressway and users can call the LATARLINE at 03-6145 1515 for any help.

LATAR Expressway has four interchanges that provide ready access to the West Coast via Kuala Lumpur at Templer's Park, the PLUS North-South Highway, and via the Guthrie Corridor Expressway. These expressways efficiently form a network to facilitate the connectivity from Kuala Lumpur, Petaling Jaya and Shah Alam and the townships it serves.

The townships include Kuala Selangor, Assam Jawa, Ijok, Bestari Jaya (Batang Berjuntai), Kota Puteri, Puncak Alam, Bukit Jelutong, Sungai Buloh, Kundang, Rawang and Selayang.

LATAR Expressway is a stress-free alternative as it offers motorists a faster safer choice in the scramble to balik kampung. It reaches to several coastal towns such as Kuala Selangor, Sekinchan, Sabak Bernam, Tanjung Karang, Teluk Intan, Lumut and Kuala Kurau.

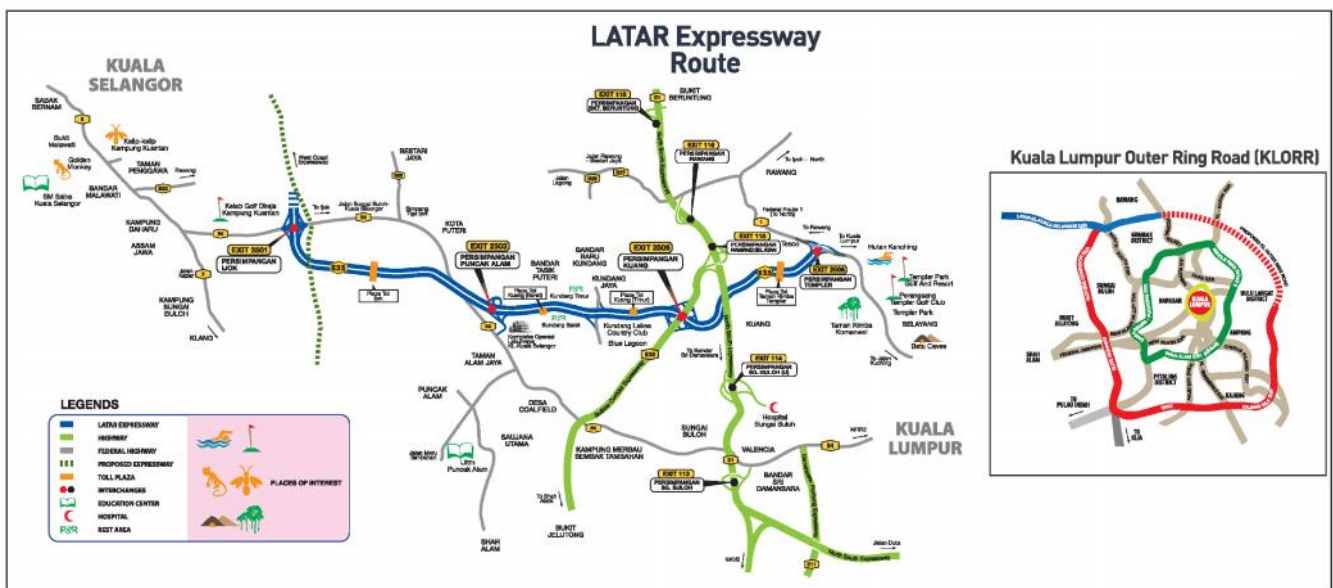
**ABOUT KL-KUALA SELANGOR EXPRESSWAY BERHAD**

KL-Kuala Selangor Expressway Berhad (KLSEB) is the concessionaire for the KL-Kuala Selangor Expressway (LATAR Expressway). The Company, formerly known as Lebuhraya Assamjawa Taman Rimba Bhd ('LATAR'), was incorporated in 1996. KLSEB is a subsidiary of Bina Puri Holdings Berhad (50%) and Rafulin Holdings Sdn Bhd through its wholly-owned subsidiary Arena Irama Sdn Bhd (50%).

Construction of the LATAR KL-Kuala Selangor Expressway commenced in 2008 when a supplemental concession agreement was signed on 28 February 2008 with the Ministry of Works representing the Government of Malaysia.

The Company achieved financial close in October 2008 with a total of RM1.04 billion loan from Bank Pembangunan Malaysia and the Islamic Development Bank.

The Company has a 40-year concession on the LATAR Expressway. The concession was awarded on a Build-Operate-Transfer (BOT) scheme in which the Company is responsible to finance, design, construct, operate and maintain the expressway.
